RE: SCHOOL TUITION/TECHNOLOGY BOOK FEE 2017-2018

Our first priority as a Catholic School has always been, and continues to be, offering a superior academic and spiritual education for the students that respects the selfless investment you make to provide a Catholic education for your child(ren).

Due primarily to the success of the BEYOND SUNDAY and Gold Envelope Campaigns, we **WILL NOT INCREASE** our tuition for the 2017-2018 school year. Tuition rates have now remained the same for three successive years. While our tuition may be a sacrifice, you should be aware of the comparison to the actual cost per student:

			<b><u>Actual Student Cost</u></b>
1 Child:	\$4980/year	\$415/month	<b>\$ 6,350/year</b>
2 Children:	\$6900/year	\$575/month	<b>\$12,700/year</b>
3 or more Children:	\$8280/year	\$690/month	<b>\$19,050/year</b>


Our current book/technology fee of \$225 per student allows us to offer students the best in instructional resources and will remain the same for the 2017-2018 school year. In order to allow more time for payment of this fee for families with multiple children, we will use the following payment schedule.

- 1 Child - Fee of \$225 due by July 1, 2017.
- 2 Children - Fee of \$225 due for the second child due by August 1, 2017.
- 3 Children - Fee of \$225 due for the third child due by September 1, 2017.
- 4 Children - Fee of \$225 due for the fourth child due by October 1, 2017.
- 5 Children - Fee of \$225 due for the fifth child due by November 1, 2017.


